

# Fall Season

August 1, 1993 - November 30, 1993

August started the fall season with relatively warm and dry weather. Shorebirds built up along the coast, and many song birds started to head south. September brought a change of weather to the region with cooler and damper conditions. A stalled cold front finally pushed through the state on September 19 bringing very cold temperatures and an excellent flight of hawks for several locations. October averaged well below normal with New England having its seventh coldest temperatures in the last century. A Halloween storm which left the first measurable snowfall for northern New Hampshire may have triggered the start of an invasion for several northern species including Common Redpolls, Bohemian Waxwings, and Pine Grosbeaks. The season ended with a vicious storm on November 28 which packed sustained southeast winds of over 35 mph and gusts of 45 to 52 mph along the coast. This resulted in a few pelagic sightings along the coast and one inland — a Dovekie in Wakefield which later died.

For the second fall in a row, an ASNH trip to Star Island was run with some very interesting results for the few who survived the torrential rain storm. A Clay-colored Sparrow was found on the island for the second year in a row and a group of shearwaters, including a Cory's Shearwater was seen from the return boat! Again showing how exciting the fall birding can be on Star Island!

The fall of 1993 was outstanding for birds. Most families were well reported with some species having excellent years. Some of the rarest finds of the season included Manx and Cory's Shearwaters, Leach's Storm-Petrel, Pomarine Jaeger, a flock of Black Guillemots, Razorbills, and Dovekies. Other highlights included a Western Kingbird, an extremely late Cliff Swallow, Clay-colored and Lark Sparrows. Four birds seen this fall get my vote as the birds of the season: Townsend's Warbler, Townsend's Solitaire, Anhinga, and Rufous Hummingbird! All are extremely rare in the state, and were seen only for brief periods or by a limited number of observers so they are still under review. Observers should carefully note all details for rare or unusual sightings and write them down as soon as possible. Sketches are good, and although clear photographs are often difficult to get, they can be conclusive for identification!

## Loons through Herons

Twenty migrating Red-throated Loons were seen moving south along the coast on November 7, while the only Common Loon reports came from inland locations. Powwow Pond in Kingston has historically been one of the best staging areas for Pied-billed Grebes in the state as large numbers stop there during migration. This fall, a count of 28 seen on October 14 may represent the largest total ever recorded in the state. The over-summering Horned Grebe found in Rye during July continued to be seen into September. A flock of 28 Red-necked Grebes at Mascoma Lake on October 3 was an unusually high number from an inland location.

Three species of shearwaters were reported offshore. Several Greater and a **Manx** were seen from a whale watch boat on the fishing banks at Jeffreys Ledge. One of the highlights of the season was a flock of 14 Greater Shearwaters and one **Cory's Shearwater** observed while coming back from Star Island on September 26. Shearwaters are rarely seen so close to shore, and **Cory's Shearwaters** are even rarer since they typically inhabit warmer ocean waters off the southeastern U.S. A strong southeast wind and foggy conditions may have brought these birds so close to shore.

The report of a **Leach's Storm-Petrel** from Seabrook Harbor on October 26 was a rare find, but is supported by the date and weather conditions. Wilson's Storm-Petrels are usually gone by this date, and the strong easterly winds may have contributed to this unusual find. An **Anhinga** was reported soaring over Rt. 93 in Hooksett by an experienced observer on August 14. There are no confirmed records of this species for New Hampshire, and due to the location and observation conditions, the state records committee will need to review the sighting. For the second fall in a row an early Great Cormorant was reported inland. This individual, an adult, was seen from Squam Lake on the remarkably early date of September 5! Great Egrets were seen from many locations this fall with several inland sightings. Two inland reports of immature Snowy Egrets, however, was even more unusual for this coastal species.



# Waterfowl

For the third fall in a row, Tundra Swans were reported from New Hampshire. This season, the two reports came from appropriate locations and times of the year for this species' migration. Both reports however, proved through photographs, to be the increasingly common Mute Swan. Mute Swans are an introduced species, most common in the seacoast region, but within the last five years have expanded their range and population in the state. Tundra Swans are rare in the state and can be distinguished from the Mute Swan by the color and shape of the bill in adults, the more horizontally held bills, a straight neck, and lack of arch in their wings while swimming.

A couple of good flocks of migrating Snow Geese were seen this fall, while the rare over-summering Brant that were first reported in July at Seabrook Harbor continued to be seen into September.

A group of three young Harlequin Ducks was a delight to find inside Seabrook Harbor on October 16, and they remained there for over a month! Harlequin Ducks are relatively rare in the state, and are almost always seen at their more preferred habitat along the hard surf of a rocky coastline. A sub-adult male Common Goldeneye was a very unusual find in the Cocheco River in Dover. It first appeared on August 30 and was present off and on throughout the fall. Normally, Common Goldeneyes are rare in southern New Hampshire before mid-October. "Dabbling ducks" were well reported with highlights including 50 Wood Ducks in Springfield, 42 Green-winged and 30 Blue-winged Teal in Rye, and 1,000 American Black Duck in Great Bay. A rare find of a Redhead barely made it into the fall season with a sighting from New London on November 26.



# Hawks

Bald Eagles were reported in record numbers from hawk-watch sites around New England for the fall of 1993. In New Hampshire, Little Round Top in Bristol logged 11 sightings for the fall, and a high one-day total of four on September 14! The species appears to have increased rather dramatically over the last ten years.

The hawk-watch site at Odiome Point was well covered this fall, and as a result some large totals of Sharp-shinned Hawks were recorded. A total of 668 was logged with the best one-day total of 239 on September 24.

A cold front pushed through the northern areas of the state on September 16 and brought clearing skies and northeast winds which produced a large flight of Broad-winged Hawks. Excellent totals were recorded from hawk-watch sites at Bristol and Farmington; however, the 4,314 counted from East Deering may represent the highest single day total ever reported for the state. On September 17 and 18, the cold front backed up and stalled over the state with cloudy skies and drizzle. The front pushed through the next day on strong northwest winds allowing for another fine day of hawk-watching and more high counts of Broad-winged Hawks.

Dan Crook moved his hawk-watch site in White River Junction, Vermont across the Connecticut River to Lebanon, New Hampshire this fall, and recorded several outstanding Red-tailed Hawk flights which have never been well documented in the state. His total for the fall season was 695 Red-tailed Hawks, with a high single day total of 242 on October 23!

Falcons were also well reported from the coastal hawk-watch at Odiome with highlights including 107 American Kestrels and 16 Merlins on September 19. A Peregrine Falcon once again returned to the NET microwave tower in Manchester where it has been seen since at least 1990. This season, it was first reported on September 27.

## **Grouse through Terns**

Shorebird highlights for the fall included good numbers of American Golden-Plovers including a flock of 14 seen during a hawk-watch in Farmington! Stilt Sandpipers were also well reported from the coast, and one unusual record came from Adams Point in Durham. A Buff-breasted Sandpiper was a rare find along the grassy areas adjacent to the runway at the Pease International Tradeport. A peak count of 74 Upland Sandpipers from this same location is 12 better than last fall's high count. Sanderlings went totally unreported for the fall. A large flock of 18 Pectoral Sandpipers on November 4 and a Spotted Sandpiper on November 23 were unusually late reports.

The only Iceland and Glaucous Gull reports for the fall were of immature birds seen on the relatively early dates of November 4 and November 14 (respectively). A Bonaparte's Gull from Lake Umbagog on August 6, and two Bonaparte's Gulls from Laconia on October 25 are unusual reports away from the coast. Tern highlights for the fall were several reports of Forster's Terns, and a flock of ten Black Terns seen migrating south just off-shore. The sighting of an adult Pomarine Jaeger in Bristol is rare; this pelagic species is most commonly seen far offshore.

## Alcids through Nuthatch

This was the best fall in several years for alcids with three species reported. The strong coastal storm that blew the Dovekie inland on November 28 also produced two sightings along the coast. Twenty-two Black Guillemots from three locations in Rye has to rank as one of the highest totals reported from land along the New Hampshire coast.

The Rufous Hummingbird, seen at a feeder in Freedom, would be the fourth New Hampshire record if it is accepted. There are very few sightings for this species in New England. A Western Kingbird made a brief appearance in Portsmouth on September 15. This western flycatcher is rare, but occurs annually in the fall in New England.

Tree Swallows were the only swallows that went reported in any numbers. No Bank Swallows were noted and Cliff and Barn Swallow totals were low. Noteworthy late swallows included 24 Tree Swallows on October 30 and one Tree Swallow on November 7. Both sightings were along the coast. A Cliff Swallow was seen in Rye by several observers on the extremely late date of November 7. This is two months later than the normal departure date for this insect-eating species; the previous late date for New Hampshire was October 7 in 1973, a full month earlier than this sighting! Could this bird have survived the cold sub-freezing weather from October and into November, or was it carried north in the southerly winds from an earlier storm?

An interesting migration of Black-capped Chickadees was noted the first two weeks in October when many dead chickadees were found under the windows of a downtown Manchester building. The peak was a three-day total of 38 dead birds collected on October 4.

# Wrens through Waxwing

About a dozen Carolina Wrens were reported this fall as the species continues to expand its range into New Hampshire. The only two House Wren reports received were both late sightings in October. Eastern Bluebirds nearly matched last fall's impressive showing as close to 200 were reported this season.

A Townsend's Solitaire was found in Concord on November 18 but unfortunately was seen only briefly by observers unfamiliar with the species. Although mockingbird and catbird appear to be ruled out by the description, the report needs further review.

A major Bohemian Waxwing invasion started in mid-November, constituting one of the largest fall totals in many years in New Hampshire. A large flock of up to 270 was counted at Plymouth State College where they fed on ornamental fruit trees around the campus.

Northern Shrikes had another poor year with no reports received. This uncommon winter visitor is erratic, however, and numbers fluctuate from year to year. The last big fall invasion came in 1990 and 1991 when 20 and 11 were reported during these fall seasons.

# Vireos through Towhee

Vireos were not well reported, with no Yellow-throated or Philadelphia Vireos and only one Warbling Vireo. A Red-eyed Vireo found in Columbia on October 17 was very late, especially from this northern area.

Warblers were better reported compared to last fall, thanks in large part to Peter Hunt's Mascoma Lake census route. Highlights from Peter for the fall included an Orange-crowned Warbler, and high totals for Blackburnian, Black-throated Green, Blackpoll, and Wilson's Warblers. Some lingering warblers included a mixed flock of six species at Odiorne Point on October 2, a Nashville and a Wilson's Warbler in Enfield on October 17, a Wilson's Warbler from Merrimack on October 19, and three Yellow Warblers and a Northern Waterthrush from Rye on September 21. The Townsend's Warbler reported from Odiorne Point on November 21 was remarkable, although only one experienced observer was able to see the bird. He gave an accurate, detailed description, however, and the date fits with some of the late fall and early winter sightings from the east coast. This western warbler has only been verified once before in the state, and this sighting is still under review.

## **Sparrows, Blackbirds, and Finches**

Rare sparrows for the fall included the Clay-colored and Lark Sparrows, both rare migrants from the western United States. American Tree Sparrows arrived for the winter right on schedule with the first reports coming on October 21. A flock of 125 Savannah Sparrows in a field in Durham is a very large number, and good totals of both Lincoln's, and White-crowned Sparrows were reported.

Along with the Bohemian Waxwings, a major flight of Pine Grosbeaks was seen this fall. In some locations, the grosbeaks and the waxwings were seen feeding in the same trees! Common Redpolls also came south in very large numbers for the first time in several years. The first flocks numbering in the hundreds were reported in early November! None of the other northern finches had an invasion year, with normal numbers of Pine Siskins, and Evening Grosbeaks reported.




